sure that her death was not in vain, but to use this tragedy as an opportunity to improve outcomes in behavioral health treatment on a macro scale.”

The Opioid Epidemic remains the worst drug related epidemic in recent history and is the leading cause of death for individuals under the age of 50. In this unfortunate scenario, Kevin’s Behavioral Health Practice has helped save hundreds of lives through Medicated Assisted Treatment and Innovative Technology to maximize Community Impact.

Passionate about leaving the world a better place than he found it, Kevin says, “I want to create a legacy that outlives me. A legacy that inspires
